TIP OF THE MONTH

Lengthen the life of your clothes dryer with regular cleaning. Clean the lint filter after every load, which improves air circulation and safety. Check the lint trap opening to ensure it's clean. Use a vacuum to remove any lint that's fallen inside the opening.

If you use dryer sheets, check the lint filter for residue buildup. Remove any residue with hot water and a nylon brush or toothbrush. Over time, dryer sheets can leave a film on the filter, which can affect the performance of the motor.

### **Grape Salad**

#### **INGREDIENTS**

2 lbs. green seedless grapes

2 lbs. red seedless grapes

8 ounces sour cream

8 ounces cream cheese, softened

1/2 cup granulated sugar

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

#### **Topping Ingredients**

1 cup brown sugar, packed

1 cup crushed pecans

#### **DIRECTIONS**

Wash and de-stem grapes. Set aside. Mix sour cream, cream cheese, white sugar and vanilla by hand until blended. Stir grapes into mixture, and pour into large serving bowl. For topping: combine brown sugar and crushed pecans. Sprinkle over top of grape mixture to cover completely. Chill overnight.
