
Where is my Account Number?


Your account number is an 11-digit number located on the top left corner of your bill and on the payment stub.

It comes as no surprise that energy use increases when the kids are home for summer break. Every appliance, from the television to the air conditioner, must work overtime. Now that school is back in session, it's an excellent time to get your energyuse back into order.

One of the easiest ways to save energy when everyone is away for the day is to install a smart thermostat.

Smart thermostats save energy in a few different ways:

• Automatic scheduling. Smart thermostats can be programmed to automatically adjust to your schedule. This means your heating and cooling system will only be running when you need it-saving you energy and money.

• Geofencing. Some smart thermostats can use geofencing to

determine when you are home and away. When you leave home, the thermostat can automatically adjust the temperature to save energy. When you return home, the thermostat can automatically

adjust the temperature to your preferred setting.

 Motion sensors. Some smart thermostats. can use motion sensors to determine when someone is in the room. When the space is empty, the thermostat can automatically adjust the temperature to save energy.

> • Learning algorithms. Some smart thermostats use learning algorithms to track your energy usage patterns and adjust the temperature accordingly. This can help you save energy without sacrificing comfort.

> > Other tips for saving energy when everyone is away is to: • Turn off all your indoor

fans and lights when away.

• Be sure all electronics (TVs, Gaming systems, computers) are switched off.

• If you have a swimming pool, adjust the filter run time to the minimum

needed. (Usually, 6 to 8 hours per day). If you need more ideas on saving energy and money, please visit our website or contact your local EMC office to schedule a free energy audit.

Chicken Marsala

INGREDIENTS

- 4 tablespoons butter
- 4 boneless skinless chicken breast halves
- 4 shallots, chopped fine ½ lb mushrooms, sliced
- ⁷² ID mushiooms, sin
- ¹/₂ cup heavy cream
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice

DIRECTIONS

Pound chicken breast to even thickness. Lightly salt and pepper each breast. In large skillet, sauté chicken in 2 tablespoons butter until lightly browned, about two minutes per side. Remove from pan and set aside. Melt remaining butter in pan and add shallots and mushrooms. Cook until mushrooms are lightly browned. Add Marsala and bring to a boil, scraping browned bits from bottom of pan. Add cream and lemon juice and return to a boil. Season with salt and pepper. Return chicken to pan for about 3 minutes to reheat and finish cooking. Serve with buttered fettuccini pasta.
