We reached out to Mrs. Claus to check out her Christmas preparations and to see how she keeps her energy cost in check during this busy season. She gladly took a moment to catch her breath and offer these tips to the Colquitt EMC membership.

• Cooking is a big one. It takes a lot of food to keep an army of Elves going, and Nick,

well, he didn't get that "belly like a bowl full of jelly" skipping meals. We bought a new induction stove this year, and I love it. It uses less energy than my old one, and I can whip up a pot of fudge in half the

time.

• Laundry is number two. Nick loves to spend time with Rudolph and the gang and can end up smelling like a wet reindeer. I used to have to wash his clothes and then unload and reload them in the dryer, but with my combination heat pump dryer and washer, I dump his clothes in the machine, and "presto," they are clean and dry in one step. #### **Texas Cowboy Cookies in a Jar**

#### **INGREDIENTS**

1-1/3 cup quick oats

1/2 cup firmly packed brown sugar

1/2 cup sugar

½ cup chopped pecans

1 cup chocolate chips

1-1/3 cup flour

1 teaspoon baking soda

1/4 teaspoon salt

#### **DIRECTIONS**

Layer ingredients in order given in a 1-quart wide mouth canning jar. Press each layer firmly in place before adding the next ingredient. • Recipe for Cowboy Cookies (To Be Attached With the Mix): Empty the jar of cookie mix into a large mixing bowl. Blend the mix together. Add 1 stick butter (melted), 1 large egg (slightly beaten), and 1 tsp. vanilla. Mix until completely blended. Shape into balls the size of walnuts; place 2 inches apart on sprayed baking sheets. Bake at 350 degrees for 11-13 minutes until edges are lightly browned. Cool for 5 minutes on baking sheet. Remove cookies to racks to finish cooling. Makes three dozen cookies.
